Scholarships Offered Through Northeast

Application deadline is February 1, 2005, unless otherwise noted. Scholarship information and application forms for the 2005-2006 academic year are available in the rack outside the Financial Aid Office. Applications must be returned to the NECC Financial Aid Office.

NOTE: Scholarships that are marked with an asterisk(*) have separate application forms. Complete as per directions.

Adult Basic Education (ABE)

Scholarship Amount: \$500

Qualifications:

1. *Apply through ABE.*
2. Must have completed more than 12 hours of instruction in the Adult Basic Education Program.
3. Financial need will be considered.
4. Students with a G.E.D. test average score of 50 or better (if test was taken prior to the year 2002) or 500 or better (if the test was taken after 2002) will have preference.

Affiliated Foods

Scholarship Amount: \$500

Qualifications:

1. Must be an employee or a dependent of an Affiliated Foods employee.
2. Must be enrolled or continuing in any regular degree program at Northeast Community College.
3. Must maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA.
4. Financial need will be considered.

Allied Health/Science

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000

Qualifications:

1. Must be an allied health or science major.
2. Must have completed 25 credit hours in an allied health or science program of study.
3. Must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5.
4. Financial need may be considered but is not a requirement.

Ambassador

Scholarship Amount: Monthly stipend

Qualifications:

1. Must be 18 years of age.
2. Must be currently enrolled at Northeast.
3. Must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA during each semester of enrollment.
4. Must have excellent verbal communication skills.
5. Must have a positive attitude toward Northeast Community College and the desire to help others.
6. Must be willing to serve as a student ambassador for at least one academic year.

Applications can be obtained in the Student Services Office of the Maclay Building.

American Association of Women in Community Colleges (AAWCC)

Scholarship Amount: \$250 (Two awards)

Qualifications:

1. Must be a current Northeast student with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
2. Must enroll for at least six credit hours in both the fall and spring semesters at NECC. Half of the scholarship will be awarded for the fall term and the other half during the spring term. Any student who does not register for six credit hours for the spring semester will forfeit the second half payment.
3. Students may re-apply for this scholarship each year.
4. Financial need will be considered.
