MINUTES

- 1. Don Oelsligle, member of the External Relations Committee, convened the meeting at 11:37 a.m. in Room 1108B of the College Welcome Center.
- 2. Recommended approval of the Minutes of the November 10, 2016 meeting.
- 3. Dr. Tracy Kruse reported that she is reaching out to the new senators in our 20-county service area. Two new senators, Joni Albrecht and Tom Briese, have been invited to campus to develop relationships with them and keep them informed of what Northeast does and the important role that community colleges serve in the state.
 - Dr. Chipps reported that he continues to monitor the state's financial status and the impact of the proposed deficit in future budgets. Shirley Petsche inquired if a budget cut would go into effect immediately should community colleges be included in the state's budget cuts. Lynne Koski indicated that first a legislative bill would need to be introduced regarding the cut, but then there are many things that could change until it goes through the legislative process.
- 4. In other business, Dr. Kruse thanked board members for their year-end donations. She reported that she and her staff are working on a Peter Kiewit grant, and a question on the grant deals with the percentage of board members who contribute; it's great to be able to say that there is 100% participation.
