- 1. The meeting was convened at 11:27 a.m. in Suite G of the Lifelong Learning Center by Jeff Scherer, Chairperson of the Facilities Committee.
- 2. Recommended approval of the Minutes of the August 8, 2019 meeting as distributed.

During a brief discussion, board members expressed their fondness of the Union 73 name after which a consensus was reached by the Facilities Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to approve Union 73 as the naming recommendation for the expanded and remodeled Student Center.
