MINUTES

- 1. The meeting was convened at 11:06 a.m. in Suite G of the Lifelong Learning Center, by Terry F. Nelson, Chairperson of the Governance Committee.
- 2. Recommended approval of the Minutes of the March 12, 2015 meeting.
- 3. A consensus was reach by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve BP-5325, Military Student Tuition Assessment and Refunds. This policy brings Northeast Community College into compliance with the requirements set forth by the Department of Defense Memorandum of Understanding.
- 4. Approximately two years ago Northeast Community College began working with the other Nebraska community colleges and the state office to develop a policy regarding records The proposed policy, BP-3070, Records Retention, brings Northeast into compliance with state law. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of BP-3070, Records Retention.
- 5. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING for DELETION of BP-1110, Philosophy. Mary Honke reported that Northeast is working to streamline what we have in policy so that it aligns with state statutes and changes do not have to be made on an ongoing basis.
- 6. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of revisions to BP-1210, Purposes.
