MINUTES

- 1. The meeting was convened at 1:05 p.m. in the Maclay Building, Room 100B, by Steve Anderson, member of the Governance Committee.
- 2. Recommended approval of the Minutes of the October 8, 2015 meeting.
- 3. Revisions to BP-2320, Meetings of the Area Board-Public Comment, were reviewed by Dr. Michael Chipps and Scott Gray. Mr. Gray advised that the proposed revisions make it easier for the public to address the Board of Governors with a public comment.
