MINUTES

- 1. Jeff Scherer, member of the Governance Committee, convened the meeting at 1:20 p.m. in Room 1108B of the College Welcome Center.
- 2. Recommended approval of the Minutes of the November 9, 2017 meeting as distributed.
- 3. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve deletion of BP-5031, On-Campus Solicitation of Students. This policy is being combined with another policy.
- 4. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve deletion of BP-5041, <u>Student Memorial Gift Policy</u>. The deletion is recommended as this is handled through procedure.
- 5. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve deletion of BP-5115, College Level Examination Program Policy. The deletion is recommended as we do not need a policy just to state that we have a procedure.
- 6. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve revisions to BP-6140, <u>Equipment and Technology Replacement Funding</u>. Revisions include the inclusion of technology in the policy to reflect current practice and referencing the associated policies.

- 7. Revisions to BP-2120, <u>Board Committees</u>, are a result of the discussion held during the November professional development session. The Human Resources Committee is being eliminated and duties or activities usually covered during that committee will be integrated into other existing committees.
 - Consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of revisions to BP-2120, <u>Board Committees</u>.
- 8. Also during the November professional development session, the consultant advised that it is good practice to have a formal policy that states a self-evaluation will be conducted periodically. A few months earlier, the Board self-evaluation policy was deleted because it was too procedural. The policy is being reinstated, changing the title from Board Self-Assessment to Board Self-Evaluation and removing the operational language. This policy allows the ability for the Board to conduct the evaluation when they so desire.
 - A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of BP-2510, <u>Board Self-Evaluation</u>.
- 9. Revisions to BP-3020, <u>Solicitation on College Premises</u> include a title change as well as incorporating language from BP-5031, On-Campus Solicitation of Students into this policy. This policy is in place to protect the students and the institution from various solicitations without going through the proper channel.
 - A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of revisions to BP-3020, <u>Solicitation on College Premises</u>.
- 10. BP-3237, Alcohol and Controlled Substance Testing for Commercial Drivers License is brought forth as part of the regular review cycle. Revisions include an update in the title and other clean up in language to bring it into compliance with the Omnibus Transportation Employee Testing Act of 1991 and its Amendments.
 - A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of revisions to BP-3237, <u>Alcohol and Controlled Substance Testing for Commercial Drivers License</u>.
- 11. Deletion of BP-5117, <u>Evaluating the Validity of a High School Diploma</u> is being recommended as the administrative procedure addresses this process.
 - A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to accept the FIRST READING for deletion of BP-5117, Evaluating the Validity of a High School Diploma.
- 12. BP-7315, <u>Employee Performance Review</u> is being recommended for deletion as the administrative procedure addresses this process.

A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to accept the FIRST READING for deletion of BP-7315, Employee Performance Review.

13. Administrative procedure governs the exit interview process, therefore, BP-7335, <u>Exit Interview Policy</u> is being presented for deletion.

A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING for deletion of BP-7335, Exit Interview Policy.
