## **MINUTES**

- 1. Jeff Scherer, member of the Governance Committee, convened the meeting at 1:49 p.m. in Room 1108B of the College Welcome Center.
- 2. Recommended approval of the Minutes of the December 14, 2017 meeting as distributed.
- 3. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve revisions to BP-2120, <u>Board Committees</u>. The Human Resources Committee is being eliminated and duties or activities usually covered during that committee will be integrated into other existing committees.
- 4. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve revisions to BP-2510, <u>Board Self-Evaluation</u>. This policy is being reinstated due to the recommendation of a consultant during the November 2017 professional development session. The policy title has been changed from Board Self-Assessment to Board Self-Evaluation and operational language has been removed.
- 4. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve revisions to BP-3020, <u>Solicitation on College Premises</u>. This policy is in place to protect the students and the institution from various solicitations without going through the proper channel.

- 5. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve revisions to BP-3237, <u>Alcohol and Controlled Substance Testing for Commercial Drivers License</u>. Revisions include an update in the title and other clean-up in language to bring it into compliance with the Omnibus Transportation Employee Testing Act of 1991 and its Amendments.
- 5. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve deletion of BP-5117, <u>Evaluating the Validity of a High School Diploma</u> as the administrative procedure addresses this process.
- 6. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve deletion of BP-7315, <u>Employee</u> Performance Review as the administrative procedure addresses this process.
- 7. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the SECOND READING and approve deletion of BP-7335, <u>Exit Interview Policy</u> as administrative procedure governs this process.
- 8. Revisions to BP-3260, <u>Child Abuse or Neglect</u>, include clean-up of and removal of redundant language.
  - A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of revisions to <u>BP-3260</u>, <u>Child Abuse or Neglect.</u>
- 9. Revisions to BP-5021, <u>Missing Student Notification</u> include general language clean-up, addition of definitions that were previously left out, and minor edits. Amanda Nipp advised that this policy is also a requirement of the Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA).
  - A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of revisions to BP-5021-Missing Student Notification.
- 10. Revisions to BP-7322, <u>Positive Discipline</u>, include an update to the policy intent and minor language clean-up. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of revisions to BP-7322, <u>Positive Discipline</u>.
- 11. Revisions to BP-7325, <u>Employment Probation</u>, include removing the language of full-time as Northeast has employment probation for part-time employees as well.
  - A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of revisions to BP-7325, <u>Employment Probation</u>.
- 12. Board of Governors members completed and submitted annual Conflict of Interest forms.
