- 3. Following a brief discussion, a consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to accept the SECOND READING and recommend to the Board of Governors the approval of revisions to BP-5150, Student Military Leave.
- 4. BP-3210, Secure College Environment is up for regular review. The proposed revisions include adding environmental, safety, and security into this policy. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING of revisions to BP-3210, Secure College Environment.
- 5. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING for the deletion of BP-3220, Environmental Safety and Health. This policy has been added to BP-3210, Secure College Environment.
- 6. A consensus was reached by the Governance Committee to recommend to the Board of Governors to accept the FIRST READING for the deletion of BP-3240, Firearms, Explosives and Other Lethal Weapons. Contents of this policy have been added to BP-3210, Secure College Environment.

- 7. In other business, review was given to the Board of Governors self-evaluation instrument. When completing the self-evaluation, Board members are reminded to answer the questions as the Board of Governors as a whole, and then answer the questions as an individual (self).
